EPF PIN Reorganizes for the New Biennium

General Convention 80 is behind us. General Convention 81 is roaring towards us in July, 2024. PIN has modified our program and structure in a quick pivot, as the biennial work begins.

PIN's Biennial Program Goals

Focus Group: Building the PIN Network

Engage new constituencies; Bring new parishes and dioceses into affiliation with PIN; Strengthen ties with Chapters & Allied Groups; Shepherd new people into PIN leadership; Educate TEC on apartheid/BDS/Christian Zionism.



Focus Group: All Things General Convention 81

New resolutions from PIN and dioceses; Build deputies & bishops caucuses; Organize zoom testimony; Work with Consultation and EPF on organizing PIN's presence at G.C.; Educate TEC on apartheid/ BDS/Christian Zionism.



Focus Group: Church, Government, World

Monitor resolutions forwarded by G.C. 80 to G.C. 81 (Rejecting Apartheid) or to an Interim Body (Rejecting Christian Zionism); Interface with TEC personnel & structures, such as Office of Gov't Relations; Communication with friends and allies; Educate TEC on apartheid/BDS/Christian Zionism.

PIN wants to partner with you. We hope to share resources, build personal relationships, and help you share your local activities with PIN activists around the country.


