TO BE ORGANIZED BY PIN

Committee 06 Social Justice & International Policy and Committee 07 Social Justice & U.S. Policy will sponsor hearings on resolutions related to Palestine/Israel. If you are aware of potential allies on either committee, please let PIN know.

Committee meetings or dates for hearings are not yet published.

Status of PIN Resolutions

Note: "C" resolutions are sent forward to General Convention after affirmation at diocesan conventions. "D" resolutions are submitted by a proposer (deputy to G.C.) and 2 endorsers (deputies).

Three "C" Resolutions naming Israel as an Apartheid State were sent forward from General Convention 80 for consideration at G.C. 81

"C" resolution from the Diocese of Rochester, NY: On Responsible Travel to the Holy Land

Recommends that Holy Land pilgrims engage the contemporary realities in Palestine and Israel and include encounters with the conditions and with Palestinians in particular in their travel.

"D" resolutions: PIN has confirmed proposers and endorsers for these resolutions. However, we are reaching out to supporters from all dioceses to become involved in endorsement and, if interested, testifying before the Legislative Committees. Get in touch with us!

Condition U.S. Military Assistance to Israel

Applies Resolution 2022-D024 that calls for conditioning aid and arms sales to prevent use in warfare, conflict or violating human rights to Israel and calls for support from OGR and EPPN.


Express Solidarity with Palestinians as an Indigenous People Recognize Palestinians as an indigenous people and apply the demands of Resolution 2012-A131 accordingly.

A Call for Ending Apartheid Against Palestinians: New Version
To complement the three resolutions referred from GC80. References the
reports of HRW, Amnesty International, and B'Tselem, calls on GC to join other
churches in naming apartheid, and calls on OGR to make ending apartheid a
priority policy.

Rejecting the Theology and Politics of Christian Zionism

Defines Christian Zionism, references its role in furthering Israel's anti-Palestinian policies, affirms Resolution 2022-A216 against extremist groups, and calls on OGR to oppose tax exemptions for Christian Zionist organizations.

Solidarity with the Palestinian Boycott, Divest, and Sanctions Movement The BDS campaign is legitimate, non-violent, consistent with TEC policy, and conforms with the 2009 Kairos Palestine statement
